OUT OF BOUNDS OR LOST BALL:

• Out of bounds or lost ball is a 2 stroke penalty - counted as 1 for your original stroke, then 1 stroke to bring the ball back into play. You will be hitting 3 to restart your play. If you are unsure if the original shot went out of bounds or is lost, hit another ball (provisional). If you find your original ball, you must play it and pick up your provisional ball.

• Your may play a provisional ball until you reach the place where the original ball is likely to be. If you make a stroke with the provisional ball from the place where the original ball is likely to be or from a point nearer the hole than that place, the original ball is deemed lost and the provisional ball becomes the ball in play

PRACTICE SWINGS & MISS HITS

• You are allowed 1 practice swing prior to hitting. However, make sure you are standing far enough away from the ball so it's not mistaken for a 'miss hit'. If you need more practice strokes, take them off the green while others are hitting. BE READY WHEN IT'S YOUR TIME TO HIT!

• If you swing at your ball and miss striking it, it is to be counted as 1 stroke...regardless of where you are hitting from.

• If you are teeing off and you whiff the ball and the ball falls off the tee, it is counted as 1 stroke

TOTAL NUMBER OF STROKES

• For pace of play consideration, a maximum amount of 10 strokes is allowed. Should you reach 10 strokes, pick up your ball, record 10 strokes on your score card and discontinue play on that hole.

NET ALONG HOLES #2 AND #4

• You are allowed 1 club length from the net and no closer to the pin with no penalty.

LONG NATIVE GRASS

• Please don't drive in the long grass. You can hit out of the long grass if you find it. If not it's a stroke penalty and drop where the ball entered.

BARB WIRE FENCE

• If your swing is impaired because your ball lands too close to a barb wire fence. You are allowed 2 club lengths away from the fence and no closer to the pin, NO penalty.

WATER HAZARD

• If your ball goes into a water hazard, a 1-stroke penalty is applicable. You are allowed 2 club lengths from the entry point and no closer to the pin. If your ball goes into the water on your tee shot, you will be hitting your third shot.

• If your ball goes into the pond on #23, there will be a 1-stroke penalty, followed by a drop on the other side of the pond in the drop zone. For example, your second shot goes into the water, you will drop on the other side and be hitting your fourth shot.

MULLIGANS/SECOND TEE SHOTS

• Your 1st tee shot is the ball you play...no "do overs". No mulligan's are allowed except in designated events

OTHER LOCAL GOLF COURSE RULES

Local Rules:

- USGA Rules govern play except where modified by local rules.
- · Keep pace with group ahead of you.
- O.B. is defined by inside edge of boundary fences, roads, & white stakes.
- #2 & 10 Hitting into range is a free drop, stance & 1 club length @ point of entry.
- #4 Hitting into net, free drop, stance and 1 club length no nearer the hole.
- #23 Take drop & hit next to green by west side of bridge after 2 shots into water!
