

# Red, White & Blue Golf Tournament Rules Sheet

## Tournament Format

The Red, White & Blue Tournament is an individual stroke play event where players move between tee boxes based on their score on the previous hole.

## Tee Colors

- Blue Tees – Back tees
- White Tees – Middle tees
- Red Tees – Forward tees

## How the Format Works

Your score on each hole determines which tee you will play from on the next hole:

- Birdie or Better → Move Back One Tee
- Par → Stay on Same Tee
- Bogey or Worse → Move Up One Tee

## Examples

- Birdie from White tees → Next hole played from Blue tees
- Par from Blue tees → Stay on Blue tees
- Bogey from Blue tees → Move to White tees

## Starting Tee Assignments

All players will begin the tournament from:  
White Tee

## Special Tee Rules

- Players cannot move farther back than the Blue tees
- Players cannot move farther forward than the Red tees
- Tee movement applies to the next hole only
- Players are responsible for tracking their correct tee assignment

## Scoring Format – Individual Stroke Play Using Handicaps

- Each player will compete using their established course handicap
- Net scores will be calculated by subtracting handicap strokes from gross score
- Handicap strokes will be applied according to scorecard handicap rankings
- Lowest net score wins the tournament
